

Terms and Conditions

Terms and Conditions

The team are working to make this a cost neutral event, as such we have worked on delegates being there for the full event. If you are not able to attend for any sections, there will be no refund. Please contact Lynley if you have any questions regarding this.

1. Registration and Payment

All attendees must register for the event through the provided online platform.

Payment is required at the time of registration and must be made through the approved payment methods. Confirmation of attendance is only guaranteed once payment is received.

2. Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellations must be made in writing via email no later than 14 days prior to the event date for a partial refund.

Cancellations made within 14 days of the event are non-refundable.

The event organiser reserves the right to cancel or reschedule the event. In such cases, attendees will be offered a full refund or the opportunity to transfer registration to a rescheduled event date.

3. Code of Conduct

All attendees are expected to behave professionally and respectfully towards other participants, organisers, and speakers.

Harassment, discrimination, or any inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion from the event without refund.

4. Use of Personal Data

By registering, attendees agree to the collection and use of their personal information for the purpose of event administration.

Attendees may also receive event-related communications before and after the event.

No personal data will be shared with third parties unless required for the event operations.

5. Photography and Media Consent

The event may be photographed or filmed. By attending, participants agree to the use of their image in promotional materials and media related to the event.

If an attendee does not wish to appear in photos or videos, they must inform the event organisers in advance.

6. Liability

The organisers are not responsible for any personal injury, loss, or damage to property incurred during the event.

Attendees participate at their own risk and are responsible for arranging their own travel insurance, if necessary.

7. Event Changes

The organisers reserve the right to modify the programme, schedule, or venue if necessary. Notice of any significant changes will be provided to registered attendees in a timely manner.

8. Health and Safety
